## CEDAR *Thuja occidentalis*

soil – moist to wet  
 roots – shallow, wide spreading  
 pruning – new growth early summer, old growth when dormant  
 note – shelter from west wind & south sun in winter

### Globe White Cedar

**Danica Cedar** zone 3 1 ●  
 height: 60cm (2 ft) spread: 60cm (2 ft)  
 A true dwarf globe-shaped evergreen with bright emerald foliage; turns bronze in winter. Keeps shape naturally; excellent for a small hedge. Slow growing.

 Pyramidal tree; soft green needles in summer. Tolerates drought & Chinooks once established.

Bushy evergreen, short candles and short rich green needles. Pinch candles in June to retain shape.

*Pinus mugo* 'Mops'

Pyramidal evergreen with orange-brown bark when mature; very long, yellowish-green needles, 3 to a bundle; deep massive taproot.

feature – peeling cinnamon bark, twisted needles

height: 8m (26 ft) spread: 2m (7 ft)  
Tightly upright, columnar evergreen; green needles. Great feature tree for small home landscapes. Fast growing.

Intense blue, very tall pyramidal tree, full branching, very thick needles.

#### **Bylands Dwarf Blue Spruce** zone 2 ○

*Picea pungens* 'ByJohn'  
height: 1m (3 ft) spread: 1m (3 ft)  
A very compact, dwarf globe blue spruce, medium blue needles, requires little care to maintain shape. Slow growing.

**Colorado Spruce** zone 2 ○  
*Picea pungens*

### CLEMATIS

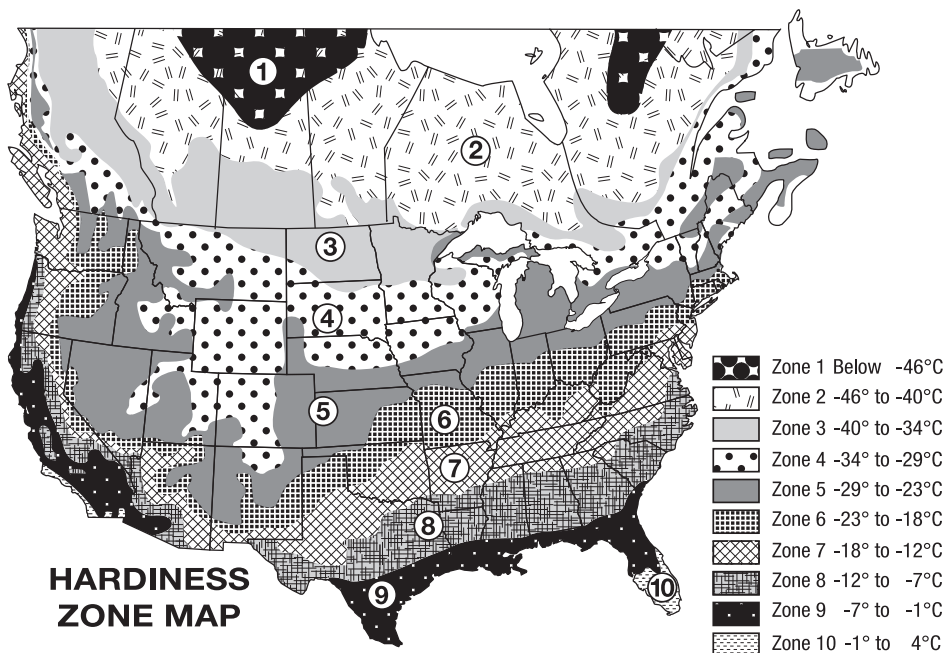

## DEER and the environment

The following list is an attempt to help you understand deer feeding habits and how these animals may be discouraged from eating the *leaves* of your garden. Remember though that menu changes from deer to deer, year to year, season to season, starving deer become bolder, and lots of food makes them more choosy. Unfortunately, some like any plant. So, there is no deer *proof* plant.

Deer **avoid** poisonous plants or a bad experience of a plant while eating.

Deer usually **don't eat** plants with coarse, fuzzy, bristly, spiny textures, or intense aromas.

In general, plants become less tasty and tougher as they mature. Many drought tolerant plants can be considered deer resistant because of tougher cell structure necessary to withstand desiccation. Drought tolerance is a quality of established plants, and trees at a reasonable level of maturity.

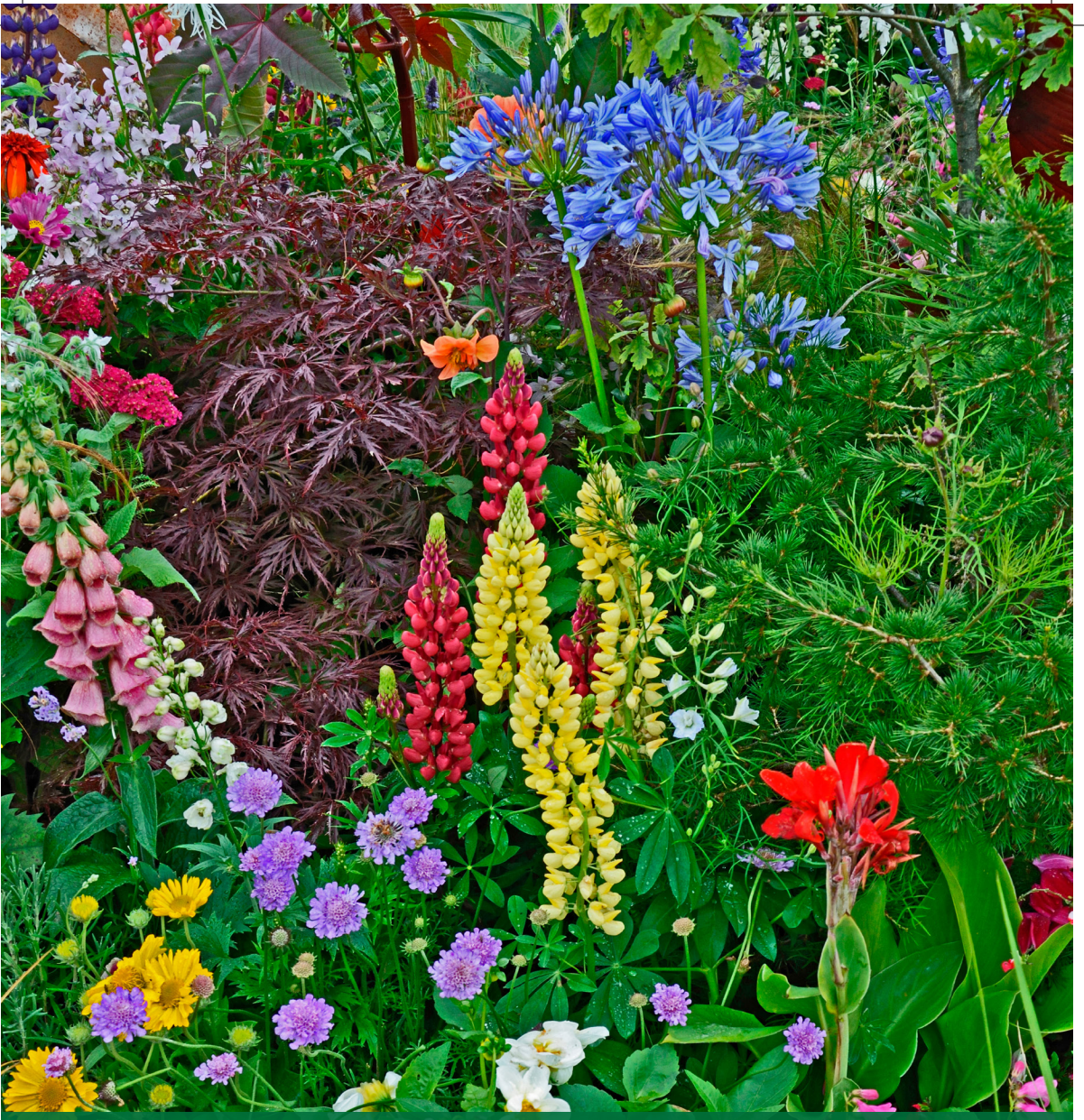

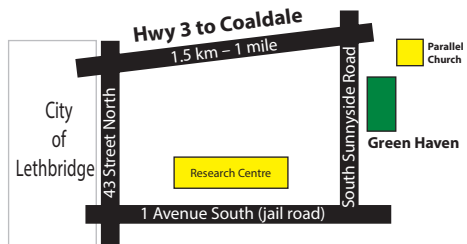
